

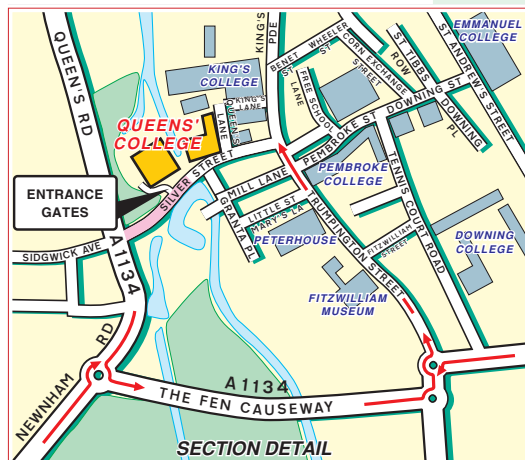





PUBLIC TRANSPORT

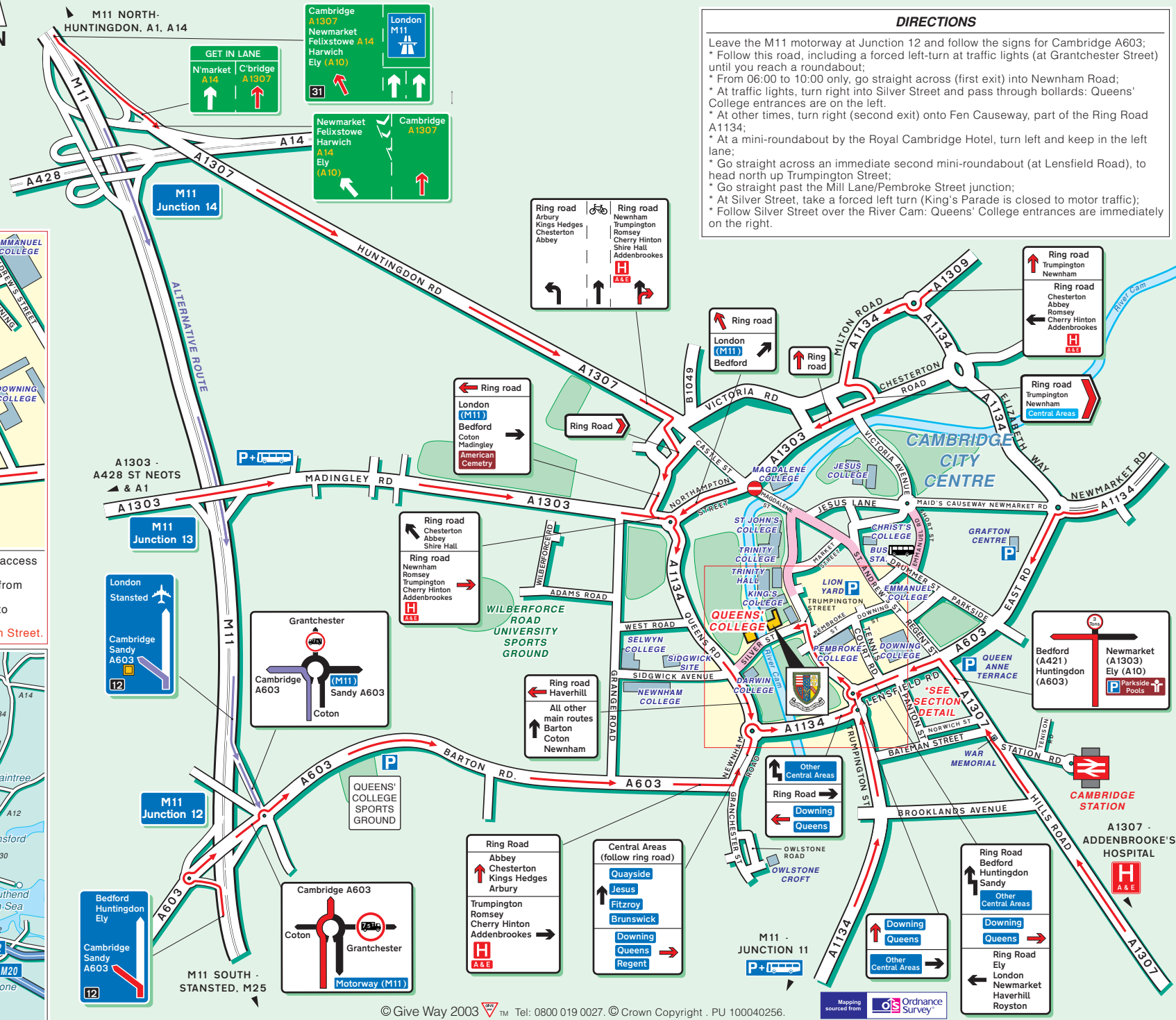
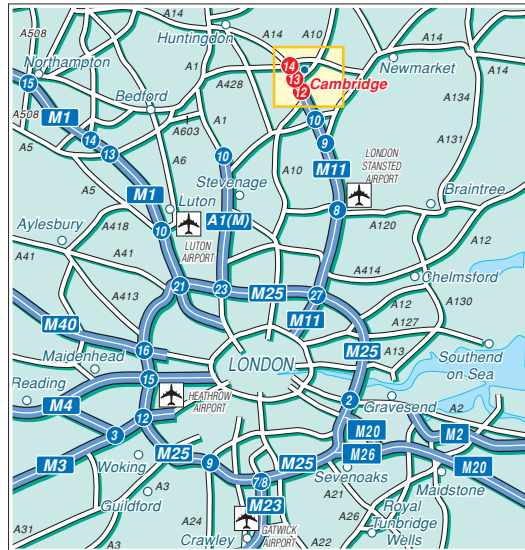
 **By Rail, Cambridge Station.**
Situating on the south side of the city, has regular services to London (Kings Cross and Liverpool Street) with a non stop journey time of approximately 55 minutes. For information on train times and operators call National Rail Enquiries on 0845 7484950.

 **By Bus,**
Coach services run regularly from Stansted, Heathrow and Gatwick Airports.

 **By Air, Stansted Airport.**
Is approximately a 40 minute journey by car. Train services run from Stansted Airport and run hourly (journey time 30 minutes).



 Bollards are now in place on Silver Street therefore access is limited.
 City bound traffic is permitted to enter Silver Street from Queens Road between 6am and 10am.
 Outbound traffic is permitted to exit Silver Street onto Queens Road between 4pm and midnight.
24 hour two way access is available via Trumpington Street.



DIRECTIONS

Leave the M11 motorway at Junction 12 and follow the signs for Cambridge A603;
* Follow this road, including a forced left-turn at traffic lights (at Grantchester Street) until you reach a roundabout;
* From 06:00 to 10:00 only, go straight across (first exit) into Newnham Road;
* At traffic lights, turn right into Silver Street and pass through bollards: Queens' College entrances are on the left.
* At other times, turn right (second exit) onto Fen Causeway, part of the Ring Road A1134;
* At a mini-roundabout by the Royal Cambridge Hotel, turn left and keep in the left lane;
* Go straight across an immediate second mini-roundabout (at Lensfield Road), to head north up Trumpington Street;
* Go straight past the Mill Lane/Pembroke Street junction;
* At Silver Street, take a forced left turn (King's Parade is closed to motor traffic);
* Follow Silver Street over the River Cam: Queens' College entrances are immediately on the right.
